### Boost digital literacy

#### Generation 0101



Free educational materials for trainers and students to develop digital skills. They are available in six different languages and include e-journalism, web design, online collaboration tools, easy coding, video, mobile application, and community radio.



#### No One Left Behind

This project allows children to use a non-leisure gaming 'toolkit' to develop digital games on mobile devices in formal learning situations. It stimulates their logical reasoning, creativity and social skills across all academic subjects while having fun.

#### Digitaly



An Italian project that aims at reducing the digital divide through the creation of online courses on ICT and free Internet hot spots in public places. It involves collaboration of several stakeholders: city halls, schools and companies.



#### MegaMission

The first digital education programme dedicated to after school clubs in Poland. Children aged 6 to 10 learn the principles of sensible Internet use through games. After ten months they become young digital experts.

#### C.R.A.F.T.



Creating Really Advanced Future Thinkers is a Danish programme to develop 21<sup>st</sup> century skills through digital means. Students learn how to solve real-life problems and create a project to compete at the Danish Learning Festival.



#### Espace Public Numérique

Non-profit centres open to the public to promote digital citizenship. They offer access, tutorials and support on information technologies and activities to help people to get familiar with the basics of Internet and its use for daily tasks.
